The limits and abilities of the machine are included, along with pre-operation checks, necessary operating procedures and methods of warning other personnel that a forklift is in the work place.

Lessons consist of the placement of the trailer tires and chock blocks, the arrangement of pallets to be able to spread out the load correctly, and checks required before driving into a trailer at a dock location. Courses likewise comprise Material Safety Data Sheet (or MSDS) training. Even if not directly related to the utilization of a forklift, MSDS training is important in case an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the correct ways of handling spills, the products and their effects on people.
