Sudbury Order Picker License - Order preparation operation or order picking as it is more commonly known is a method utilized within warehouse operations and comprises workers referred to as order pickers. The order picker's duty is to take and collect articles in particular quantities to accomplish the client's orders before shipment. Order picking is an easy warehousing method. The effectiveness in which this particular task is done could be directly connected to the productivity of a supply chain. Therefore, order picking is among the most controlled logistic processes. Order picking falls in the category of the warehouse management system.

There are some certain types of order picking. The main types comprise: pick to box method, wave picking method, picker to part method or piece picking, zone picking method and sorting systems method.

The pick to box method comprises the order picker just filling the boxes with stuff that are from their specific station. The box then moves on to other locations to until the order is done. In this technique, there is no movement of the order picker employees. In the wave picking method, the order pickers move all-around so as to collect the required products for numerous orders. The piece picking or picker to part method is similar where the order pickers or picker move to gather the stuff required but for one order only.

There is no movement by the order picker in the sorting systems method. Rather, things are brought to the orderpicker by an automatic system like for instance a conveyor system or an automatic storage system. In the zone picking method, every order picker is assigned to one particular area. They are responsible for just realizing order picking within this specified area.
